Plans for Spending

This Prop 28 funding presents an opportunity for Independence School to enhance its arts education offerings. Potential areas for development include: steAm education, visual arts, and media arts, aligning with California's updated arts standards.

Independence will allocate \$26615.00 to supplement steAm instruction by paying a 120 to a certificated teacher to grades K-12.

Independence will continue allocating \$2000.00 in Prop 28 funding steAm ancillaries for our K-12 students to use in VAPA and STEAM clubs and supplemental instruction.

Independence will allocate \$4654.00 in Prop 28 funding to the steAm Room (P-16) to be used by our K-12 students for steAm activities during and outside of the school day for supplementary instruction, enrichment and exploratory education.
