Plans for Spending

The proposed expenditures for staffing include:

\$180,000 for approximately 8 sections for teachers to be able to work on a .33 (working without a prep).

\$5,500 for 100 hours of teacher pay at the adjunct rate to help with the theater program.

\$51,867 remains. This has yet to be determined. As staff schedules change throughout the year this will be reevaluated.

The proposed expenditures for materials and supplies include:

\$20,000 for supplemental materials for the Performing Arts classes.

\$39,342 for supplemental materials for the Visual Arts classes.
