The remaining 20% of funds will be used for purchasing supplemental materials such as technology/graphic LED display TV/Panels, instruments, and supplemental art, media, photo, computer, murals, and design programs to enable students to gain a greater understanding of the arts and music program so that students can develop their college and career goals.
